



YEAR 1 - AUTUMN TERM

ENGLISH

As part of our theme of 'My Place in the World' we will be: -

- Talking about ourselves and our family using describing words.
- Discussing what makes us special.
- Using stories to write basic sentences.
- Using stories with predictable and patterned language.
- Extending our reading and spelling skills.

MATHS

In Maths we will be extending our knowledge of numbers and our ability to count reliably to 100, forwards and backwards. There will be an emphasis on recalling addition facts for all numbers to 10.

We will also cover aspects of:

- Addition and subtraction.
- Money and real-life problem solving.
- Measures (length) including problems.

TOPIC

A warm welcome to Elvetham Heath Primary School's Year 1 classes. This term we are very excited to have 'My Place in the World' as our topic, which presents lots of opportunities for creative links across the curriculum and interesting activities for the children to get involved in.

COMPUTING

In computing we will be learning basic computer skills including logging on.

SCIENCE

In Science our theme is 'Animals including humans'. We will be learning about the basic parts of the human body and which part of the body is associated with each sense.

MUSIC

We will be identifying different sounds and using them expressively in response to a stimulus.

RE

We will learn about the Harvest festival and how Christians celebrate it.

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ART

In Art we will be making 3D sculptures out of clay.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about the local environment. The children will develop their understanding of where they live, and begin to learn to follow a simple map.

PSHCE

We will be learning to recognise, name and deal with our feelings in a positive way. We will also be exploring how our behaviour affects other people and how to make new friends.

Outdoor PE - Games - We will be focusing on developing our ball skills, particularly bouncing and dribbling, building up to playing some simple ball games.

Indoor PE - Dance - We will be looking at basic shapes and using our body to balance and create routines.
