

CLUBS AVAILABLE AT EHPS – JAN to MAR 2018

Internal

Art (Y1) – Art (Y2)

Each session will focus on a different skill throughout the term.

Board/Card Games (Y4-6)

Have fun playing various board and card games or even creating your own games to play.

Book Club (Y5&6)

We will read an age appropriate book together and will critique and comment as we go along! It will be fun!

Creative Writing (Y3-6)

In creative writing club we work towards making a book each term. In the past we have made a school magazine and a collection of short stories. This term the children have been given writing challenges and the best ones have been chosen for our book.

Fashion Design (Y2)

Children will design, draw and colour a different outfit each week to create a fashion book.

Hama Beads (Y1&2)

Make your very own hama bead design to take home.

Lego (Y1) – Lego (Y2)

Each week the children are set a Lego challenge to complete. They then show their creation to the rest of the group and tell us about it.

Loom Bands (Y3&4)

We create a range of different objects using loom bands such as bracelets and charms.

Netball (Y5&6)

Netball is an all-inclusive sport, it can be played by females and males. A wide range of positions allows for different skill levels. We will focus on various skills over the term including throwing and catching; spatial awareness, travelling around the court and the rules of netball and competitive games.

Percussion (Y4, 5 & 6)

‘Make some noise’ Does your child like music? Do they have rhythm? Would they like to play many different instruments including the school drum kit? Can they build a piece of music with percussion only? Would they like to talk about favourite tracks and artist with their classmates? If the answer is yes then they would love percussion hour!

Pop-Up Cards (Y4-6)

Each session you will make a fold-out card with a 3-D construction that pops out at you when you open it. This fun activity will develop your cutting gluing and building skills.

Science & Technology (Y5&6)

We will be undertaking weekly science and technology tasks to gain the CREST STEM Award (STEM = Science, Technology and Maths).

Sewing (Y3)

Weekly sewing activities.

Sketching & Drawing (Y3)

Drawing club is a great opportunity for children to show their creativity, focus, perseverance and to become more confident using their skills. We draw and shade patterns, still life, portraits, human figures and festive artwork.
