



YEAR 1 - AUTUMN TERM

ENGLISH

As part of our theme of Paddington's Peru we will be: -

- writing instructions
- character descriptions
- describing a setting
- writing a story
- concentrating on writing simple sentences using capital letters and full stops.

MATHS

In Maths we will be extending our knowledge of numbers and our ability to count reliably to 100, forwards and backwards. There will be an emphasis on recalling addition facts for all numbers to 10.

We will also cover aspects of:

- Addition and subtraction
- Money and real-life problem solving
- Measures (length) including problems.

TOPIC

A warm welcome to Elvetham Heath Primary School's Year 1 classes. This term we are very excited to have 'Paddington's Peru' as our topic, which presents lots of opportunities for creative links across the curriculum and interesting activities for the children to get involved in.

COMPUTING

In computing we will be learning basic computer skills including logging on.

SCIENCE

In Science our theme is 'Habitats and how the seasons affect them'. We will be learning how living things adapt to survive in different habitats, variation between living things and environments change.

MUSIC

We will be identifying different sounds and using them expressively in response to a stimulus. We will be participating in a Latin music workshop.

RE

We will learn about the Harvest festival and how Christians celebrate it.

ART

In Art we will be making 3D sculptures out of clay.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about the local area and comparing this to Peru. We will also be learning the names of the continents and the oceans.

PSHCE

We have started the year learning about the famous people behind the school's four different houses. We will be learning to recognise, name and deal with our feelings in a positive way. We will also be exploring how our behaviour affects other people and how to make new friends.
