

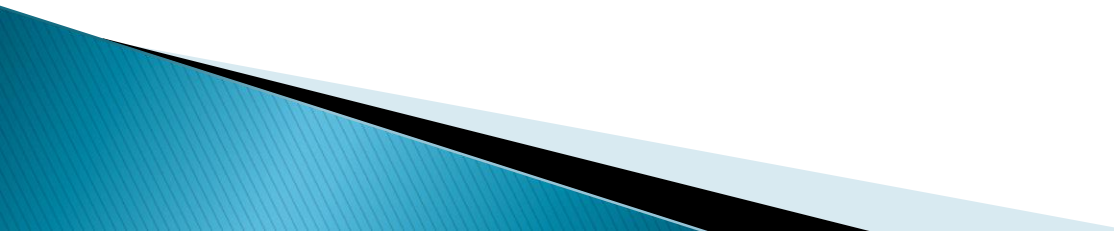

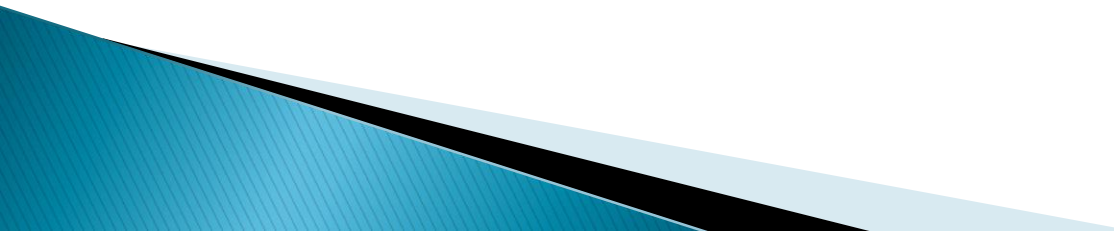

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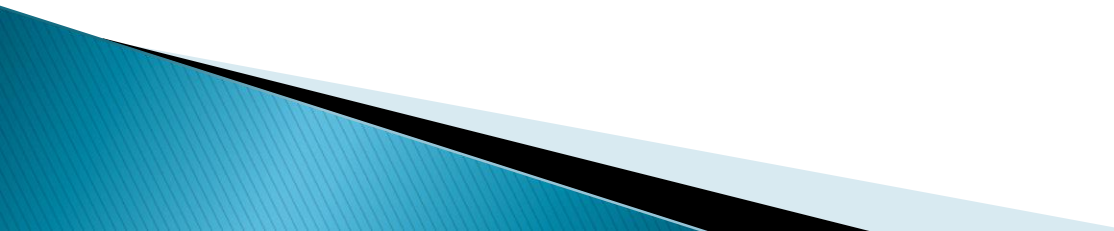
What changes are there?

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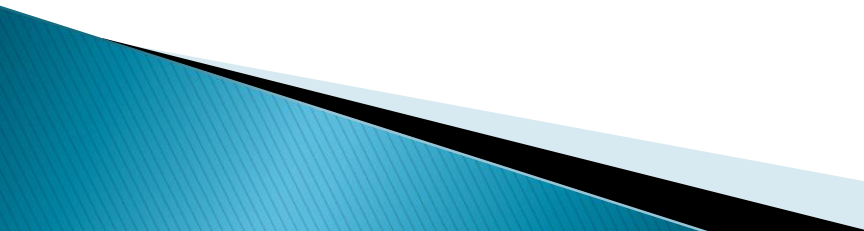

 - Encourage them to spell the words correctly in their homework
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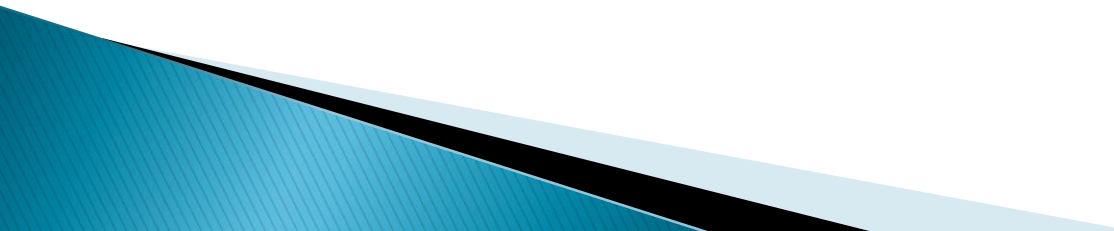

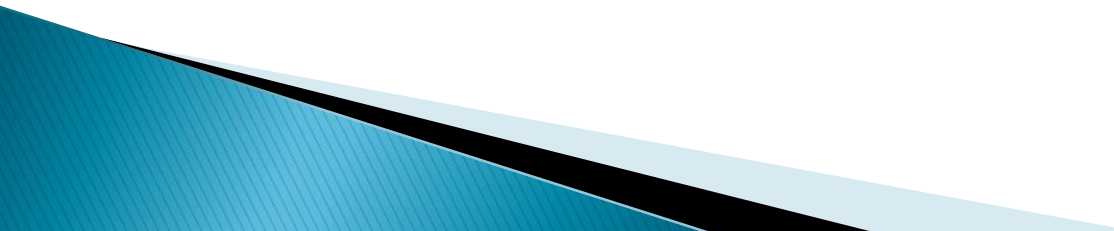
Morpurgo and Grahame – Thursday and Friday

How can you help?
